

This instruction page is to explain how to use the app and the gesture-based controls.

When the app starts, you will be provided with a list of files that have been loaded onto the iPad.

Each file can be selected and, if Voiceover is active, the contents will be described.

Press once on a filename to open it. Voiceover users are then warned that the app shuts down that system when active.

Once the file is open and the tactile sheet placed over the screen, then the system is fully accessible.



OverLay is designed to enhance simple graphics, tactile or not, with a rich, multilayered audio experience using the iPad's touchscreen.

Printed pages are placed over the iPad screen to match the OverLay onscreen graphic.

Our custom-made trays enable easy and secure positioning.

There are three ways of accessing audio information in any graphic. Try them all on this symbol:-

- Single tap in the circle centre
- Double tap in the circle centre
- Swipe from left to right



At the top left of the screen is the button to return to the main menu.

Any defined point on the screen can be used in all three ways so it is possible to drill down for more information at the user's request.

Also, there are six buttons at the base of the screen which can be used for extra audio.
